Cheer Program Information

All Star Cheer Guidelines and Information

- Spirit Athletics offers 3 different programs that are designed to fit the needs of our athletes and families according to skill level, time and financial commitments. We offer Novice, Prep and Elite cheer. All our teams are full year commitments from June - April.
- Athletes are placed on teams according to their age and skill abilities. We will place athletes according to the success of the child as well as the team. We typically are still evaluating athletes after try outs (June - August) so there is a slight possibility your child may move to another team that best fits your child's skills and abilities more appropriately.
- All teams are charged monthly tuition that is based on the program your child was placed on. These fees will be outlined in your parent handbook, all fees must be paid on time and are the responsibility of the parent. Credit card **MUST** be placed on file, no exceptions. Added fees can be charged for missing practices the week of a competition or missing a competition (\$300). Extra practices might be called during the season at no extra charge, however if a practice is cancelled during the year there are no refunds.
- All teams will attend competitions and events throughout the season and parents are expected to be responsible for any travel expenses that might incur. The competition schedule will be released in July but is subject to change if needed. Certain teams will be required to travel out of state, so please make sure you're aware of the travel required for your child's particular team.
- Competitive teams are a season-long commitment with a signed financial contract for the full season's amount. If an athlete quits, then they forfeit all items on orders and no refunds will be issued. If an athlete quits after choreography, then they will accrue a \$500 drop fee.
- Spirit Athletics is a member of the USASF, who provides safety policies to gyms, our staff and all events that we will be attending this season. All athletes must register with the USASF and become a member in order to compete with our gym. Athletes cannot compete without this compliance membership. All parents must go on the website and create their child's profile and pay the fee (\$49) directly to the USASF. This must be done by October 1st or your account will accrue a late fee.
- All families are required to create an account online via our website (Spiritathletics.net). Monthly payments will be automatically withdrawn according to the payment schedule that is outlined in the handbook. Siblings will receive a tuition discount, please ask the front desk for that information.

All Star Cheer Guidelines and Information (cont.)

- Junior and Senior teams are eligible for bid events that will require them to travel to Orlando, FL. We will be accepting bids/ Invites to the D2 Summit and The Worlds Championship. This is NOT an elective event; if your child can not attend, please tell front desk/ staff immediately so we can make arrangements to accommodate your wishes.
- In an effort to allow the athletes to focus, and keep negative chatter down in the lobby, team practices and classes are not open to viewing. Parents who promote a culture of negativity, gossip or complaining may have their child removed.
- Parents are expected to stay up to date on all information in our gym and can do so by utilizing our communication pages. We will be using the BAND App this season to stay informed. We will also have a monthly newsletter that will be emailed out to all our families as well.
- The use of the logo, gym name, team names etc. are NOT permitted to be reproduced or used on any items. Parents are NOT allowed to create their own clothing for any events or competitions. Parents doing so will be removed from program.
- Spirit Athletics requires all athletes and parents to act with integrity on social media. Please do not engage in spreading any hatred or negativity regarding our gym, staff, athletes, or parents. Please do not use these public social forums or platforms to express grievances regarding practices, events, vendors or our team/staff/athletes.
- Athletes are expected to show up to practice on time in the correct attire with hair in high ponytail with designated hair accessory. Attendance with incorrect attire will result in team conditioning and fees and/or reordered practice wear after 3 warnings.
- There is a \$75 fee for missing camps and choreography, you will need to work with your coach on an approved fill-in. It is your responsibility to find your replacement.
- Our program/staff train with passion and intensity, our athletes will be expected to work hard and give their best effort every practice. Our program places a high value on competitiveness, and we have high expectations, intense coaching and we require strong levels of discipline, effort and passion from the athlete and a sports focused mindset from the whole family.
